1. COVID-19 ORANGE TRAFFIC LIGHT RESTRICTIONS

It is expected the event will be run under the Orange Covid-19 Protection Framework current at the time of the event. Currently that means My Vaccine Passes are not required.

Face masks must be worn in the Secretariat Office (Media Room).

5. **DRIVERS BRIEFING**

A written drivers briefing will be emailed to all competitors by Friday 29 March.

A written new drivers briefing will be held at 8:30am by the stairs to Race Control by the tunnel between the pit garages.

6. **DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING AUDIT**

6.1. **Documentation**

Electronic documentation is being used. Competitors must send copies of their car club membership card to secretary@aucklandcarclub.org.nz or 021-889-488.

6.2. **Scrutineering Audit**

Log books will be collected by Series Coordinators. Scrutineering will start from:

7:30am on Sunday 30 April at the track.

Audits will take place in garage 19.

7. **RESULTS**

Results will be distributed to Series Coordinators. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, competitors should not come to the Secretariat office or Race Control to collect them.

8. **WITHDRAWAL FROM THE MEETING**

In order to avoid unnecessary contact, competitors withdrawing from the racing should send a text message to the Secretary on 021-889-488 advising name, vehicle number and Series, or just give him a call. Please do not come to the office.

9. **TRACKSIDE PIT LANE AND PIT WALL**

- Alcohol – there is to be no alcohol consumed in the pits until after the last event of the day.
- Cigarettes – there is no smoking in pit lane, pit garages or the parking area immediately behind the pit garages.
- Footwear in pit lane – covered footwear must be worn in the pit lane.
- No glassware is to be taken to the pit wall.
- There is no stopping in the fast lane of the pits at any time.
- No refuelling is permitted in the trackside pits.
- No children under the age of 14 are allowed in the pit lane.

Please note that children must be supervised in the pit area at all times. Any motorised vehicles are to be ridden and driven by license holders only. Please remember that scooters, pushbikes and skateboards are to be kept under strict control.

10. **GARAGES AND PIT AREA**

When jacking on any asphalt area competitors are required to use jacking boards for the jack and base board for sitting any axle stands on. Anyone using the garages must unload and then move the trailers and support vehicle leaving the rear of the garages free.

11. TRAILERS

Once you have unloaded your race car your trailer must be removed to the area shown on the venue plan (the grass area at the far end of the garages). You will be asked to move your trailer if you are seen to be leaving it in any area other than the allocated place as this may restrict the movement of emergency vehicles.

12. WALKWAY BEHIND GARAGES

Please be aware that the yellow line behind the garages to the garage doors is a walkway. NO trailer ramps are to be left over this line to be closer to the garage. If you do extend over the line you will be asked to move back behind the line.

13. GENERAL

- The dummy grid is the paved area by the Timing Building (on the far side of the Administration Building).
- No non-competition or officials' personal vehicles are permitted in pit lane.
- For all sessions, cars will be called from their pits by loud speaker.
- Listen carefully for your Series to be called.
- If you are late for the dummy grid you will have to start from pit lane.

14. SAFETY

The Clerk of the Course reserves the right to exclude, either before or during the race, any vehicle or driver which is considered to be unsuitable or unsafe.

15. FINAL POSTIONS

The first, second and third place positions and all subsequent positions will be the cars that finish in that order upon crossing the chequered flag. These will be the cars that have completed the most race distance/laps upon the flag fall.

16. HIRED TRANSPONDERS

Hired transponders will be placed in bags for collection by the Series Coordinators. Series Coordinators will distribute them to competitors.

It is important that hired transponders are returned to the Series Coordinator after your final race.
